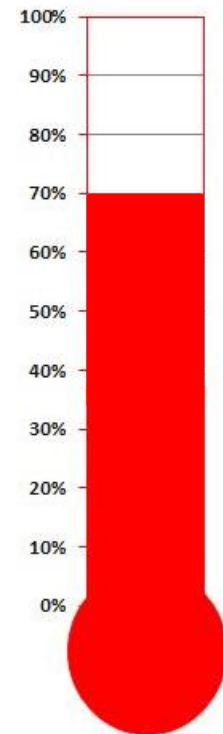

## Last week's meeting

President **Erin Kennedy** rang the bell to open the meeting followed by Past President **Laura Lewis** leading an invocation and the pledge of allegiance. **Tom Hall** and **Steve Rath** led a rendition of "Oh, the Auction is a Coming."

President Erin courageously gave a personal update. She acknowledged the prayers and well wishes for her "interesting journey." She cited the power of prayer and the "miracles along the way" she has already experienced.

**Introduction of Guests:** President-Elect **Jack Neely** brought the introduction of guests. Visiting Rotarian Dan McVey (Zanesville Daybreak) and a visitor from the Logan Club were present. Past President **Mike Massaro** introduced student guests from Watkins Memorial High School and principal Ben Richards. Past President **Gary Baker** introduced Utica High School students and Lisa Ritzer, a guidance counselor from the school.

### Announcements:

- President Erin reminded members of the monthly service project accepting the donation of coats in October.
- Past President **Tony Adams** shared the date of Dec. 4 for the bus trip to a Blue Jackets hockey game accompanying Big Brothers, Big Sisters. The maximum is 47 seats for members and the accompanying guests.
- The annual auction, which will have been completed by the time of publishing of this article, is set for Saturday. **Jim Withers** gave his last pre-auction update which included translation from the German-speaking General Goldfinger (aka **Jerry Besanceney**). General Goldfinger's German was ever so gently scrutinized later by the German-born, first language German-speaking speaker for the day.
- The "Three-About-Me" for the day was a two-fer. **Dave List** was present to acknowledge being the first one and **Scott Kennedy** got "top husband" honors on the second one.

**Sergeant-at-Arms:** **Pat Jeffries** fined Scott Kennedy, all five Cub fans in the room, **Bill MacDonald**, **Nancy Neely**, **Ed Bohren**, guest Ben Richards, anyone admitting to not going to the Rotary Auction, and anyone not having grandkids.

**Program:** **Rick Platt** introduced the day's speaker, Roland Schillo of xperion, as representing not just a new company, but a new industry. He also added a speaker background tidbit about the circumstances of our speaker being a Cincinnati Bengals fan from Southern Germany. Schillo explained the carbon fiber and compressed natural gas industries in which xperion operates at a facility in Heath. His remarks centered around the reasons xperion and its parent company Avanco chose to enter the U.S. market and chose Licking County. The decision to enter the U.S. market in the middle of 2012 culminated this year in their first U.S. production.

The speaker acknowledged the "team effort" as the top reason Licking County and Central Ohio were selected. He further added that he, personally, found the area to be a good spot to relocate his family as well.

The business opportunities, particularly in the fleet segment, and the stability of the domestic U.S. natural gas market has him upbeat on the future of his industry.

He got some laughs talking about the weather claiming he was told Central Ohioans can "golf year round" here and that our cold 2013 winter was the worst one in 30 years. He joked, "I found you can golf year round, you just need a snow plow."

A robust Q&A session yielded his prediction that the deployment of CNG tanks in personal cars is "going to take a while" in the U.S.
