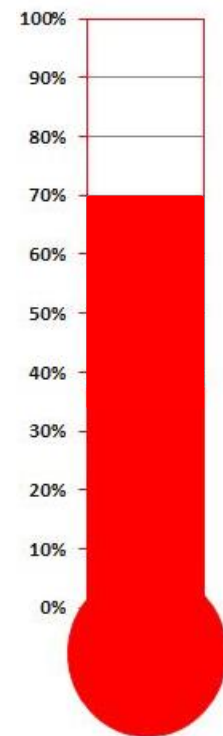

**Sergeant-at-Arms: Pat Jeffries** fined our newest member **Victoria Reed**, he fined all Rotarians of businesses employing the 20 under 40 (group of future community leaders published in The Advocate), He also fined **Dave Shull**.

**Our Program:** Today's program speaker was introduced by **Tom Cummiskey**: State Rep. Scott Ryan.

Scott opened his speech by giving us his thoughts on three issues facing us this Election Day. Issue one: This is popular issue and sees it passing easily with people. Issue two: He called it a constitutional issue for the constitution to split issues on the ballot where a monopoly could occur; he was for this. Issue Three: This is an attempt by 20 investors who put up 40 million dollars for their own monetary gain. This is an important issue as Ohio could be a catalyst for other states if this passes. He is definitely against this issue.

Scott explained in simplified terms the process of how a bill travels through the House and Senate of Ohio. From introduction to the end process, bills can have a life of their own once they are introduced, the wording and even the original intent of a bill can change dramatically through its cycle.

Scott complimented Licking County on how well we pull together to get things accomplished. We are held in high regard in state government as other counties are not so fortunate.

Scott said he took some firefighting training to get a better idea of how firefighters operate. He visited the Lucasville prison and was impressed with the employees on how they were dedicated to their jobs.

Scott talked about capital safety grants and is fighting to change them as he has an issue on how the money is distributed. As it stands now out of every \$10, \$9 goes to someone who does not need it and only \$1 goes toward the cause.

Scott closed by thanking us for the invitation to speak and fielded some questions.

Colonel Victoria H. Reed has retired from as the Director of Air Force Metrology and Calibration Program located in Heath. She coordinates all aspects of the apprentice and work programs for high school students and networks with Central Ohio business and industry to develop and expand opportunities for career technical students. She is also active in her local community as the director of the Market Street Food Pantry, sits on the Vestry at St. Luke's Episcopal Church, is a member of the STEM advisory board at The Works, and celebrates her Scottish roots by serving as the Ohio Commissioner of the Clan Campbell Society.
