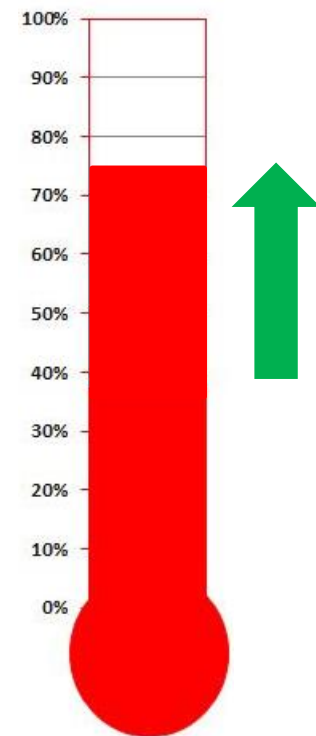

**Pat's joke:** Sheriff Randy Thorp pulled over a little old lady after she went through a stop sign. Mrs. Smith hands Sheriff her concealed carry permit and he asked her what she had: Mrs. Smith said "357 Revolver, 9MM semiautomatic in glove box, 22 M Derringer in right boot an AR 15 in the trunk with a shotgun". Sheriff Thorp asked Mrs. Smith "Are you on your way to or from a gun range?" "Mrs. Smith, "No". Sheriff Thorp "What are you afraid of?".....Mrs. Smith "Absolutely NOTHING."

- Attorney General Mike DeWine is in charge of monitoring the process set up by the Legislature
- Sondra Schlaegel works with Sheriff Thorp on Concealed Carry Permits. Sondra passed out a CCW Booklet and a Frequently Asked Fact Sheet Flyer.
- Permit requires 8 hours class, with 6 hours online and 2 hours required hands-on safety training.
- After the California shootings, sheriff received 140 phone calls where citizens wanted information
- Cost \$67, background checks, laws have changed in Ohio over the years
- If you are traveling to other states, go to Attorney General website and look at all agreements with other states so you are not in violation. About one-half of the states have a reciprocity agreement.
- Licking County since 2004: issued 10,000 permits; 2,000 permits issued in 2015 with 800 renewals; people getting the permits are responsible, no issues to date, very responsible.
- Overall since 2004 violent crime has gone down.
- With CCW, you can carry weapon anywhere in car/truck at this point in time; if pulled over, windows down, hands in plain view, interior light on, let officer know where weapon is.
- 9 people this year have been denied typically due to criminal record
- Increase in women applying: 33% seeking permits are women
- Bad guys with evil intentions are going to get firearms and you do not want to take the right away from responsible citizens.
- No permit needed to own a firearm kept in your home.
- Sheriff's office has recalled concealed carry permit in case of domestic violence
- Concealed Carry Permit does show up on your license.
- Employer can post signage if do not allow concealed carry.
- Open carry is legal now.
- How do you transport a weapon to a shooting range if you don't have a concealed carry permit? You cannot have access to weapon from inside the vehicle, must be unloaded, in plain view with action of the weapon open. Best method is keep in trunk of vehicle. Ammunition in a separate place.
- **If you see something, say something.** Police depend on all of us to pay attention.
- Concealed Carry Permit holders are confidential
