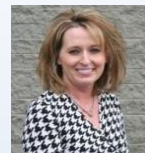
**Program:** Nelson McCray then introduced our guest speaker, Larry Hughes, the Hartford Fair Manager. Larry has been active in the fair for 67 years. The Hartford Fair was first discussed and planned in 1857, with the first fair being held in 1858. The fair is unique in Ohio because it is not a county fair, but an independent fair, with participation and support from townships in three counties – Licking, Knox and Delaware. Only a small portion of the operating funds come from the participating counties and townships; most funds come from fair operations and local fundraising contributions and donations. The red roofs on the buildings are a well-known trademark of the fair. A large focus is creating a venue for children to participate through 4H and open class animal shows. Auctions of farm animals raised over \$900,000 last year. The fair board is extremely appreciative to the numerous contributions of local community leaders who have provided property and money to continue to improve the event.
