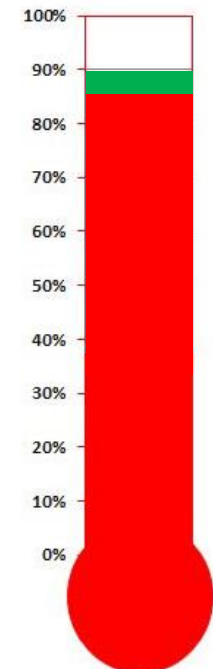

Committee Reports:

- Our Polio Plus campaign, started in 1985 has reduced the number of cases from 385,000 to just 6, in Pakistan and Afghanistan. During March all fines will go to Kick Cancer.
- **Mike Massaro** reported on the Rotary Foundation. We need more participation in the Rotary Annual Fund. Be sure to check on your status to see if you may be eligible to name someone as a Paul Harris Fellow. Seventeen Newark Rotarians are already qualified to do this.
- The Playground 100th Anniversary renovation is on schedule. JBA Architects is working with the City of Newark on the roadway issues.

- **Eriech Horvath** reported that our 100th anniversary project is just \$50,000 short of our goal of \$500,000. We are at 87% participation among Rotarians in supporting this effort.
- **Steve Ehret** announced plans to create a 100th Anniversary History Book for our club. **Chris Diebold**, **Glenn Abel** and **Jerry Nethers** are working on this project.
- **Angie Ryan** is this year's Auction Chair and **Jennifer Roberts** is in charge of the Gala.

The balance of the meeting consisted of Roundtable discussions to come up with ideas for improving our already great Rotary Club.

Meet new Rotarian: Deb Dingus

Deb currently serves as the Executive Director of the United Way of Licking County and is currently called to serve on the pastoral team at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Newark as an ordained minister of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. Deb received a B.A. from Capital University in 1987 in Elementary Education and Christian Education. While completing her college degree, Deb also completed a year at the University of Dar-es-Salaam, in Tanzania, East Africa while also working with missionaries in the Meru region. Deb received her Masters of Divinity in 1992 from the Lutheran School of Theology in Chicago with an emphasis on Cross Cultural Studies. During her graduate work she trained in community organizing through the Appalachian Ministries Educational and Research Center in Berea, Ky., and completed her project work with training at the Highlander Center in Tennessee. Part of Deb's graduate work also included receiving a certificate in social science facilitation from Texas A&M.
