## Last week's meeting

**President Jack Neely** opened the meeting followed by **Jennifer Utreis** offering the invocation and leading the Pledge of Allegiance. An unaltered version of "April Showers" was led by **Tom Slater** with accompaniment by **Peter Larson**.

**Introduction of guests:** President-Nominee **Chuck Moore** introduced guests Judge Craig Baldwin (**Tim Fitterer**), Harry Paleer (**Denny Hesselgesser**), Tristan Ruml and Brendan Underwood (**Rob Klinger**). **Michael Noble** introduced Licking Heights students and **Nancy Neely** introduced Northridge students. The students would follow with brief, but articulate remarks. **Bill MacDonald** introduced The Ohio State University at Newark students and **Bonnie Coe** introduced Central Ohio Technical College students. The COTC students' bios were read.

### Announcements:

- President Jack introduced the Club's April service project matched up with one of Rotary's Five Avenues of Service—clean water. **Bob Williams** pointed out the sign up sheets and the Saturday, April 9 Riverview Park opportunity for service.
- **Bob Fitzgerald** noted the Club-led Free Enterprise Academy is seeking juniors in high school for the June program which has already attracted 50 student applicants. Bob encouraged Rotarians to consider their relatives as applicants and to also consider signing up to volunteer.
- The "Three About Me" was a stumper. **Jon Spahr** admitted to be the mystery Rotarian.

**Sergeant-at-Arms: Pat Jeffries** was in 100% fine mode again this week. **Dave Hile, Trevor Thomas, Jeff Anderson, Bonnie Coe, Bill MacDonald, Bill Cost**, and owners of pit bulls were the first to be fined. Then, attention turned to the NCAA basketball tournament. Two North Carolina fans, a couple "Vanderbilt" fans (mistakenly named but attracting a fan base nonetheless), Villanova fans, and those "who didn't care" were all fined to close out the sergeant's work for the day.

**Program: Past President Tom Marcelain** introduced the week's program — Jo Ellen Cline, counsel for the Ohio Criminal Sentencing Commission. Cline led a PowerPoint presentation about the Ohio Supreme Court-affiliated commission which was established in 1990 and first met in 1991.

The job is to study Ohio laws, sentencing patterns, and juvenile offender dispositions with recommendations to the General Assembly. The Commission is, by law, chaired by the Chief Justice of the Ohio Supreme Court. In 2015, our own, Judge Marcelain, was Vice Chair.

Cline recited a revitalized structure, complete membership, and new staff as the momentum of the current commission. The 31-member commission now uses a committee structure that allows other interested people at the table in a "collaboration of interest." Listed accomplishments included new publications for judges on sentencing.

Legislation pending with the current General Assembly would change juvenile dispositions. In a controversial matter, the Commission recommended that parents should not have to pay restitution on behalf of their children. The Commission is looking at mandatory sentencing, bail reform, and juvenile bind over to adult court among issues on its plate in the future.

A robust Q&A followed, including exploring what is done for victims (represented on the Commission and always considered in policy) and thoughts on the recent *60 Minutes* program on Germany's criminal justice system (Ohio is getting "more progressive," but "won't get there).
