**Sergeant-At-Arms: Pat Jeffries** fined a lot of Rotarians primarily dealing with the grand opening of the Canal Market District.

**Program:** Free Enterprise Academy Chairman Bob Fitzgerald thanked our club for sponsoring the program and thanked all committee members helping out this year. Bob then went on to introduce our speaker Rotarian Rob Montagnese president and CEO of Licking Memorial Hospital.

Rob spoke about leadership and the lessons he has learned. He compared a for-profit company to a non-profit company, pointing out their similarities mostly dealing with customers and employees. Like a good company, a well-run hospital is very important to the economy of a community. Rob spoke about building trust and loyalty to a business or organization by having the employees develop a sense of ownership in their place of business. Everything has to be subordinate to what is in the best interest of the customer.

Rob gave us a number of tips for success that can be used in business as well as life.

- Perception is reality.
- When you find yourself in a hole, stop digging. Admit to your mistake, correct it, and move on.
- If you're miserable, don't make everyone around you miserable.
- You don't build a business for yourself. You learn to know what people want and build it for them.
- Constantly raise the bar: Do your best work and try to trump it. "The best

time to get better is when you're already good. The best way to get started is to quit talking and start doing."

- We judge ourselves by our intentions. Others judge us by our actions. Make sure they match!
- Be willing to change.
- Value all employees and whatever anyone is doing inside the organization. No matter how small that role is, it's important.

Rob concluded by giving a little more advice to the future college kids in attendance: Don't limit yourself to a particular college when looking for one, grades are important, and punctuality is important.
