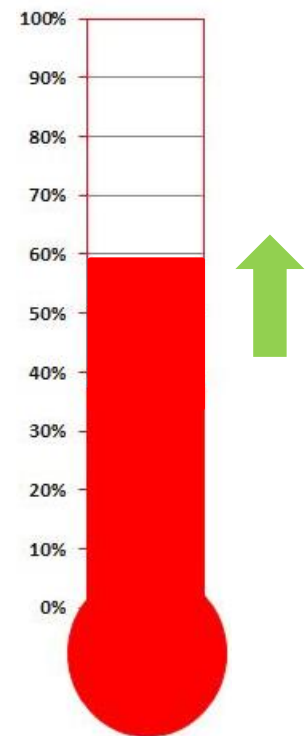

**Tom Cummiskey introduced the program.**

Dr. Johnson reported that Battelle has more than 22,000 employees in 130 countries around the world. They are heavily supportive of STEM education and STEM schools. They believe in teaching the importance of teamwork and persistence. They like to say that STEM stands for Strategies That Engage Minds. There are 35 STEM schools in Ohio and Tennessee. These schools provide the students with opportunities for group work, online assessments, digital skill-building games and teacher-led instruction. They also stress the need for mentoring and getting more women interested in STEM fields.
