**Program:** **T.D. Griley** introduced Martha (Marty) Helman of the Boothbay Harbor Rotary Club in Maine. Marty and her husband Frank joined this Club in 2003 and in 2012-2013 she served as Governor of District 7780 (southern Maine & coastal New Hampshire). Marty & Frank are Paul Harris Society members, Major Donors & Bequest Society members of The Rotary Foundation, and through the corporate support of the Otto and Fran Walter Foundation, they are Arch Klumph Society members.

Marty began by mentioning that **TD** is on her list of senior Rotarians that have been very supportive of her and her efforts over the years. She currently serves The Rotary Foundation as Vice Chair of the Peace/Major Gifts Initiative. She conceived of, and chaired, the Sakuji Tanaka Endowed Rotary World Peace Fellowship Committee, which raised \$1 million for the Rotary Peace Centers. This was the largest sum ever raised by a Presidential fund. She partnered with author and PDG Dave Forward to edit and produce the book, "String of Pearls," which tells the story of selected Rotary Peace Fellows.

Marty went on to explain the history of the Peace Foundation. In 1921, "Peace" was added to the Bi-Laws of Rotary, with an emphasis on education. Rotarians would later help popularize the idea of "Study Abroad," with the idea that if people can learn about other cultures, directly from the people of that culture, we would all grow a better understanding of each other.

Marty closed by stating that, "the work we do on a community level may seem small, but little acts done by many communities add up to big things internationally." When asked what Rotary is, please respond, "Rotary is a global organization that is working hands on to making peace."
